## Event Rules

1. Be sure you are registered under the correct class. Once your vehicle is parked we will not change your class.
2. Your Entry Card should be displayed under left windshield wiper as soon as you are ready to be judged.
3. Entries must be ready for judging by 12 noon. Judging will begin at 9 AM, if your Entry Card is on your windshield. There will be a sticker placed on your Entry Card once your vehicle has been judged.
4. All vehicles must stay in place until awards are presented.
5. Entries will be judged with open hood and trunk; vehicle windows and convertible tops up. If your Entry Card is on your windshield, we will assume that you are ready for judging.
6. No commercial signs or sale signs are permitted on judged vehicles. Ownership and vehicle informational signs are optional. Pony corral vehicles may post sale signs.
7. In the event of a tie, VMU head judge will cast a deciding vote. Judge's decisions are final.
8. No alcohol or weapons are permitted.
9. Shoes / sandals are required.
10. No bikes, skates or skateboards are allowed in the show areas.
11. No unregistered vehicles and no tents will be permitted on the show lot.
12. It is recommended that each vehicle place a fire extinguisher next to either front wheel.

## Judging Rules

please read carefully

Your car will be judged on quality of workmanship, condition and cleanliness only.

You will be given an Entry Card at registration. As soon as your car is ready to be judged, please place this card on your windshield and notify the judge's table that you are ready. We plan on starting by 9:00 AM, so help us out and get your car ready as soon as possible.

Trunks and hoods **MUST** be open to allow for judging those areas. If they are not, you **WILL** not receive points for those areas.

All vehicle windows and convertible tops must be **UP** so that they can be judged. Again if not up, no points will be awarded.

The owner or a substitute should be at car when judged to answer judges questions, and to open and close doors and trunk for judging. **JUDGES WILL NOT DO THIS.**

Your car will be judged by two judges and a total of points from both will be the final score.

If you want your judging sheet, please address an envelope to yourself at the judges' table and pay \$1.00. It will be mailed to you **AFTER** the show.
